Last Week's Program

Lara Akl School on Wheels

Lara Akl is a volunteer engagement coordinator and the OC representative for School on Wheels, a local non-profit providing learning opportunities to homeless youth in the counties of Southern California. Lara holds a Masters degree in communication and marketing.



She speaks 3 languages, including her native Lebanese. Growing up in war-torn Lebanon, she witnessed her mother struggling to raise her and her several siblings, and experienced displacement, resulting in attending 7 different schools.

This background has led Lara to be passionate about education, and with a desire to break the cycle inn which the homeless find themselves. Homeless students are more likely to experience:

4 x drop out

3 x special education programs

2 x poor scoring on standardized testing 9 x repeat grades/classes

School on Wheels was founded in 1993 by teacher Agnes Stevenson, beginning as a "homework club". Later, a learning center was established in LA's skid row, offering afterschool transportation, free tutoring and mentoring. Today, School on Wheels offers free year-round one-on-one tutoring at any library, park or other quiet space suitable for learning, free backpacks and school supplies, scholarship programs, positive rolemodelling and mentorships. It offers customized curriculums, referrals and additional support for the families.

The organization partners with school districts and community organizations in its outreach to students. Interested individuals and organizations can help by volunteering, donating, "spreading the word", and helping to connect via social media.
