She began coaching in 1985, due to witnessing the lack of sports activities for her daughter who had Down's Syndrome. In 1991, she was asked to volunteer with TOPSoccer, and this became her life's work and passion.

The annual TOPSoccer Festival, held in July, is done of their largest events with various fun skill/exercise stations for the participants, food, and special guests - all at no charge. This year is the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Festival, and will be on Saturday 7/13, at Brookhaven Elementary. The theme is "Planting the Seed, Growing Our Community".
