Rose Melin Allergic Emma

Rose is the mother of 9-year old Emma, who suffers from multiple food allergies. Emmas's story is an inspirational one, how she faced challenges and turned them into positives.



As an infant – as young as 9 days old – Emma began experiences a series of health difficulties which were initially thought to be choking, acid reflux, etc. At age 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ months, she was started on foods, and began displaying allergic reactions. At 18 months of age, she was diagnosed with having food allergies. The list is quite lengthy, although somewhat shorter than it was previously. Her primary allergies are tree nuts, peanuts, milk, horses, and guinea pigs. She can have reactions to soaps and other products, depending upon their ingredients.

Note: in school, there were 2 Emmas; in she was nicknamed "Allergic Emma" in order to differentiate which Emma was being referenced.

32 million people have food allergies. And knowing this, here is where Emma shows how truly amazing she is. At 6 years of age, and during coVid, she asked her mom if she could launch her own You Tube channel, with the goal of helping other kids suffering from food allergies. She has continued her quest to help others, and to raise food allergy awareness.

Emma has earned a number of recognition honors due to her efforts:
