Previous Week's Program

Kaii Lee The Pacific Symphony

Kaii Lee is a retired professional vocalist and pianist, music teacher and coach. Her extensive musical background has led to her active volunteerism with the Pacific Symphony. She resides in Irvine, and is familiar with Rotary, as her husband was previously a member of the Irvine club.



Did you know that the Pacific Symphony is the largest symphony established during the last 50 years in the USA. It was originally founded as the Pacific Chamber Orchestra in 1978, eventually moving its home to the Segerstrom Concert Hall in 2006. It is a highly

regarded and recognized: in 2018 The Pacific Symphony was invited to perform at Carnegie Hall; in 2019, it was named OC Arts Ambassador of the World, and played at Ellis Island and China.

Today, it conducts a number of programs, many providing opportunities for youth in diverse musical disciplines. It offers free community concerts, and provides music education for 68 thousand students annually.
